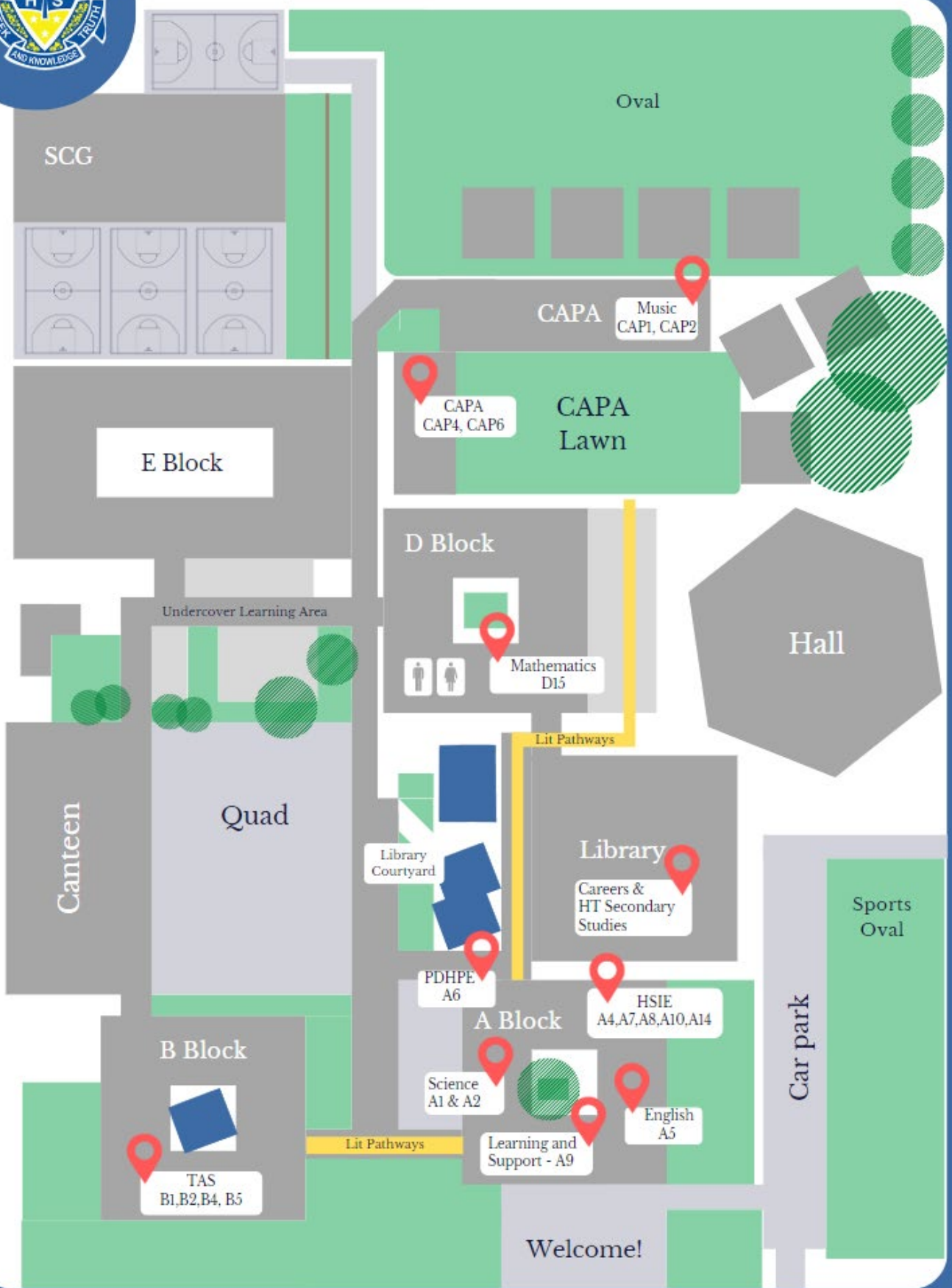

STEP 1



SUBJECT SELECTION BOOKLETS

Booklets explain the changes to student learning as part of their HSC and provide a summary of every course offered at WHS.

Booklets are distributed during week 7, Term 2

STEP 2



COURSE VIDEOS ONLINE

Students will access the WHS website Subject Selections page to hear from teachers as they overview the courses on offer from each Faculty

STEP 3



SUBJECT SELECTION EXPO

Parents and carers are invited to attend WHS on the 14th June (Wednesday week 8) to hear directly from the careers team, senior school coordinators, and subject teachers

STEP 4



TASTER EXPERIENCES

Students attend dedicated lessons to sample 8 courses of interest for their HSC. Students undertake an authentic learning experience and are given an overview of the course during Week 3, Term 3

STEP 5



CAREERS INTERVIEWS

Students can self nominate to be interviewed by a careers team member, with the option for parents to join the meeting. Interviews ensure a students selections align their interests with career destinations

STEP 6



FINAL SELECTIONS

Students must submit their preferred subjects, in priority order online by Thursday the 17th of August (Week 5, Term3.) These selections allow WHS to form a timetable.
